What is Enrichment?

Enrichment occurs daily between 1.10pm and 1.40pm. It is a time where children can follow their interests, try new things and expand their knowledge and skills. It is arranged around mixed age groupings which fosters new friendships, and is driven through the interests and passions of the Staff who deliver it. Children make their choices of clubs at the start of every half term with the hope that they might try something new to them. The enrichment clubs on offer also change and adapt with the seasons.

Clubs on offer . . .

Boules (Y3-4 and Y5-6) Have some fun mastering this game. How skilful will you be??!!

Drawing and Colouring Club (KG-Y6) Relax and enjoy some quiet time colouring, drawing or completing a dot-to-dot puzzle.

Zumba (KG-Y6) Have fun learning dance routines, creating your own and performing / teaching them to each other.

Library / Reading (Y2-Y6) Library - gain confidence when reading aloud, reading and speaking in public, how to stand, breathe and rest, use expression, eye contact, project voice etc.

Matilda & Three Little Pigs (KG-Y6) Learn songs, dances, refine your acting talents. Build the props and help with the whole production.

Origami (Y3-Y6) Find out how to transform a plain square of paper into an animal, flower or other ingenious item purely by folding. Y3-6

Pom Pom making (All year groups) Make a traditional multi-coloured Pom Pom from wool ends. Make a lot to make a garland, or glue on googly eyes to make a face.

Debating club (Y4-Y6) Your chance to talk about your opinions and explain your views on issues that affect you and society, and to explore how people decide what is fair and unfair.

Sewing club. (Y3-Y6) This term we will be designing and making a felt bookmark.

Board Games (KG-Y2) Do you dream of being 'Snakes & Ladders' Champion? Are you great at 'Guess Who'? Come and join us for some traditional fun!!

Reading / Storytelling (KG-Y6) Let's read books and tell stories together! You can bring in your favourite books to share. Let's have an adventure!

Wildlife (Y3-6) Could you be the next David Attenborough? We'll explore the school grounds and see what we can find! We can then draw what we see or make some interesting crayon rubbings.

Lego Club (Y1-4) Build amazing models, show off your talents, make the impossible!

Dodgeball (KG-Y2) Dodge the ball, hit your opponents with your ball, play as a team and win!

Rugby club (Y3-6) Boys and Girls, it's time to learn how to pass, catch and score in the glorious game of rugby. Improve your speed, agility and co-ordination as part of a team and come and give rugby a 'try'!
